**Abstract:**

In recent years, with the continuous development of aviation science and technology, Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) are becoming more and more popular. For example, aerial photography and air surveillance are all increasing. As related technologies are becoming more and more miniaturized, performance of such UAS has been significantly improved. However, safety problem it generates also becoming increasingly serious.

In view of this, The Hong Kong Institution of Engineering Surveyors (HKIES) would introduce **UASSOC**, in conjunction with the **HKIES UAS Registration System (URS)**, aiming to encourage "self-regulation" culture among UAS owners and operators, and to create a safe environment for using UAS in Hong Kong.

The spokesmen will brief the "Charter" and relevant safety issues related to the use of UAS in Hong Kong.
